**MOTION APPROVING BUDGET AND SALARY SCHEDULES**  
(AUGUST 24, 2010)

MR. CHAIRMAN:

BASED ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS AND HIS STAFF, I MOVE THE ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR, INCLUDING THE RECOMMENDED SALARY SCHEDULES FOR PROFESSIONAL AND AUXILIARY PERSONNEL, AND FURTHER,

WHEREAS, SPURGER I.S.D. EMPLOYEES HAVE CONSISTENTLY PROVIDED VALUABLE SERVICE TO THE STUDENTS, PATRONS, AND TAXPAYERS OF SPURGER I.S.D., AND

WHEREAS, EMPLOYEES OF SPURGER I.S.D. ARE DESERVING OF A PAY INCREASE, CONSISTENT WITH THE FISCAL PRUDENCE THIS SCHOOL BOARD IS ENTRUSTED TO PROVIDE, AND

WHEREAS, CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THIS BOARD MAKE IT NECESSARY THAT A TAX RATE ROLLBACK ELECTION BE CALLED FOR NOVEMBER 2, 2010;

I MOVE THAT, ACCORDING TO THE SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION, ALL SPURGER I.S.D. CERTIFIED CONTRACT EMPLOYEES BE GIVEN THE STATE-DESIGNATED SALARY INCREASE, AND THAT ALL AT-WILL (10 MONTH) EMPLOYEES BE GIVEN A 2% SALARY INCREASE, FOR THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR, **CONTINGENT UPON, AND SUBJECT TO,** PASSAGE OF THE TAX RATE ROLLBACK ELECTION TO BE ORDER NOVEMBER 2, 2010.

**ORDINANCE ADOPTING TAX RATE**


The Board of Trustees, Spurger Independent School District, hereby levies or sets the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2010-2011 at the total tax rate of \$1.31, to be assessed and collected by the duly authorized assessor and collector as follows:


\$1.17 for maintenance and operations; and

\$ .14 for payment of interest and principal on debt

Such taxes are to be assessed and collected by the tax officials designated by the District.

TAX RATE ROLLBACK ELECTION ORDER

On this the 24<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2010, the Board of Trustees of Spurger Independent School District, located in Spurger, Tyler County, Texas, convened in regular session with the following members present:

*Eddie Jordan, Rusty Roberts, Willie Gill, Chris Sheffield,  
Paul Bingham, Carroll Hatton*

and the following members absent: *James Broucher*

constituting a quorum, at which meeting the following, among other proceedings, was conducted by said Board:

It was moved by Trustee Carroll Hatton, and seconded by Trustee Paul Bingham, that an order be adopted calling an ad valorem tax rate rollback election to ratify and approve the \$1.31 ad valorem tax rate adopted by the Spurger Independent School District on August 24, 2010, for the 2010-2011 school year, which tax rate is \$.14 above the rollback rate of \$1.17. Such election is to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010. The order being read and put to a vote, the same was unanimously adopted by those present. The order as adopted is as follows:

ORDER CALLING AN AD VALOREM TAX RATE ROLLBACK ELECTION IN THE SPURGER INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, LOCATED IN TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS, ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2010, TO RATIFY AND APPROVE THE \$1.31 AD VALOREM TAX RATE ADOPTED BY THE SPURGER INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT ON AUGUST 24, 2010, FOR THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR, WHICH TAX RATE IS \$.14 ABOVE THE ROLLBACK TAX RATE OF \$1.17.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED by the Board of Trustees, Spurger Independent School District, located in Spurger, Tyler County, Texas, that an election be held, and notice is hereby given that an election will be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, in the Spurger Independent School District, located in Spurger, Tyler County, Texas, to ratify and approve the \$1.31 ad valorem tax rate adopted by the Spurger Independent School District on August 24, 2010, for the 2010-2011 school year, which tax rate is \$.14 above the rollback tax rate of \$1.17.

ELECTION JUDGES AND POLLING PLACES:

Said election shall be held at the following place in the following voting precinct, and the following named person who is qualified so to serve under the provisions of the Texas Election Code, is hereby appointed the officer of said election, with the assistance of such duly qualified clerks as she may elect to designate:

At the Spurger ISD Vocational Agriculture Building, 12212 FM 92 South, Spurger, Tyler County, Texas, 77660 and said election shall be conducted at said voting place by the following officer:

Mary Lou Jeans, Judge,  
with the assistance of those qualified  
persons she shall appoint as clerks

All those legally qualified to vote at said election residing within Tyler County voting precinct No. 4, lying within the boundaries of Spurger Independent School District, shall vote at the Spurger ISD Vocational Agriculture Building.

POLLING PLACES WITH CONSOLIDATED PRECINCTS:

In accordance with Section 4.004(d), Texas Election Code, the following voting precincts have been consolidated, for purposes of this election, at the polling places indicated below: NONE.

VOTING ON ELECTION DAY:

The polls at the above-designated polling place shall be open on Election Day, November 2, 2010, from 7:00 o'clock a.m. until 7:00 o'clock p.m.

EARLY VOTING BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Early voting by personal appearance ballots shall be provided at the Spurger I.S.D. Administration Office, 12212 Hwy. 92 South, Spurger, Tyler County, Texas, 77660, and said early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at said voting place by the following officer:

Cheryl Spangler, Judge,  
with the assistance of that qualified  
person she shall appoint as clerk

All those legally qualified to vote at said election residing within the Spurger Independent School District and registered to vote in precinct No. 4 shall be entitled to cast their early voting by personal appearance ballots in person at the Spurger I.S.D. Administration Office, 12212 Hwy. 92 South, Spurger, Tyler County, Texas, 77660. Said place of early voting by personal appearance shall be open from 8:00 o'clock a.m. until 4:00 o'clock p.m. on each day for early voting by personal appearance which is not a Saturday, a Sunday, or an official State holiday, and early voting by personal

appearance shall begin on Monday, October 18, 2010, and continue through Friday, October 29, 2010, pursuant to Art. 85.001(a), Texas Election Code. The Spurger I.S.D. Administration Office, P. O. Box 38, 12212 Hwy. 92 South, Spurger, Tyler County, Texas, 77660, shall be the voting place for all early voting by mail. Early voting by mail shall be conducted during the same period as early voting by personal appearance, except that envelopes containing mailed ballots must arrive at the address shown on the carrier envelope before the polls close on Election Day, unless otherwise determined to be timely pursuant to Article 86.007, Texas Election Code.

CONDUCT OF ELECTION:

The manner in which said election shall be conducted shall be governed by the Texas Election Code, and this Board of Trustees will furnish all necessary ballots and other election supplies requisite to said election. Mr. Joseph R. Fisher, a duly qualified person, is hereby appointed to serve as presiding judge/ballot board judge.

QUALIFIED VOTERS:

Each qualified voter in said District shall have the right to vote at said election. Any qualified voter residing within the Spurger Independent School District not assigned to any voting box may vote at the nearest voting box to his residence, if the judge of the election finds him qualified.

ELECTION RETURN AND CANVASSING:

After said election has been held, the officials holding the same shall return to the President of the Board of Trustees, in a sealed envelope, a copy of the return, poll list and tally sheet for said election, and its set of election returns shall be used by the

Board of Trustees in canvassing said election. Another copy of the return, poll list, and tally sheet of said election shall be delivered to the President of the Board of Trustees in an unsealed envelope, and this envelope shall be available in the office of the Superintendent and open to inspection on request by the public during regular business hours for sixty (60) days subsequent to the date of the election.

NOTICE OF ELECTION:

The Board of Trustees shall give notice of said election, stating in substance the contents of this Election Order and the time and place of said election and of absentee balloting, and other information required by Articles 4.003 and 4.004, Texas Election Code, and the President of the Board of Trustees is hereby authorized and instructed to post or cause to have posted said Election Order and notice at two (2) public places where notices are customarily posted in this School District, and said posting shall be made at least twenty (20) days before the date of said election.

The President of the Board of Trustees shall also cause to have published a notice of said election in newspapers of general circulation in Tyler County, Texas, where this School District is located. Said publication shall occur not more than thirty (30) days nor less than ten (10) days before the date of said election.


NOTICE OF MEETING:


It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of the Board of Trustees, written notice of the date, hour, place and subjects of this meeting has been posted on the bulletin board, located in the Spurger I.S.D. Administration Office, P. O. Box 38, 12212 Hwy. 92 South, Spurger, Tyler County, Texas, a place convenient to

the public, said notice having been so posted and having remained posted continuously for at least the seventy-two (72) hours preceding the date of this meeting.

It is further found and determined that this district is entirely located in Tyler County, Texas, the county in which most, if not all, of this district's pupils reside, and that written notice of the date, hour, place and subjects of this meeting was furnished to the County Clerk of Tyler County at least seventy-two (72) hours preceding the date of this meeting. The original of such notice shall be attached to the minutes of this meeting and shall be a part thereof for all intents and purposes.
