

COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROVISION (CEP)

Spurger ISD is announcing a change to its policy for serving meals to children served under the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program for the 2018-19 school year. Schools qualifying to operate the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) provide breakfast and lunch to all children at NO CHARGE and eliminate the collection of meal applications for free, reduced-price, and paid student meals. This new approach reduces burdens for both families and school administrators and helps ensure that students receive nutritious meals.

****All meals, breakfast and lunch, will be FREE to all students.**

****Second meals and a-la-cart items ARE NOT COVERED BY NSLP. THESE ITEMS will be priced separately with NO CHARGING**

Charge Policy

PK-5th grade - There will be NO CHARGING a-la-cart items or second meals.

6-8th grade - There will be NO CHARGING a-la-cart items or second meals.

9-12th grade- There will be NO CHARGING a-la-cart items or second meals.
